

Expedited Appointments

We help primary practitioners to find the earliest available appointment when our injured workers need to see a specialist or to have a diagnostic performed. A primary practitioner is a doctor, chiropractor, physical therapist, nurse practitioner or other care provider.

We ask specialists and diagnostics clinics to give us appointments that are not being used by the general public. The appointments may be in the evening or on weekends, or may involve travel to another city. We prefer to use Saskatchewan specialists and diagnostics. We will use out-of-province services if we need to. We cover travel costs for our injured workers.

Primary practitioners access specialist services by asking us for a list of specialists with early appointments – A direct referral can be made. Let the specialist know that the appointment is for a WCB injured worker.

We have lists of available diagnostic services. We will make appointments if the primary practitioner asks for one. The primary practitioner may be asked to complete a requisition.
