






**Time Loss Injury Rates\***





**Average Cost in Registration Year by Claim Type\***








**Time Loss Injury Rates\***








**Time Loss Injury Rates\***








**Time Loss Injury Rates\***








**Time Loss Injury Rates\***




**Time Loss Injury Rates\***






**Time Loss Injury Rates\***




**Time Loss Injury Rates\***




**Time Loss Injury Rates\***




**Time Loss Injury Rates\***




**Time Loss Injury Rates\***





**Premium Rates - Per \$100 Assessable Payroll**




**Time Loss Injury Rates\***





### Average Cost in Registration Year by Claim Type\*














### Time Loss Injury Rates\*





**Average Cost in Registration Year by Claim Type\***










**Time Loss Injury Rates\***







### Premium Rates - Per \$100 Assessable Payroll




**Time Loss Injury Rates\***



### Average Cost in Registration Year by Claim Type\*








**Time Loss Injury Rates\***








**Time Loss Injury Rates\***





### Average Cost in Registration Year by Claim Type\*










**Time Loss Injury Rates\***




**Time Loss Injury Rates\***






**Time Loss Injury Rates\***









**Average Claim Duration (Days)**






